Please submit a project statement outlining and expounding upon the project you are hoping to work on during the course of this Fellowship.

- Brief bio (100 words max)
- Resume (1 2 pages)
- 3 references from an academic and/or professional setting
- One letter of recommendation (this can come from someone also listed as a reference)
- 7-10 digital images no more than I MB each and an accompaying image list that includes artist name, title, medium, year of completion, dimensions, and name of file.
